Please also see Form S1 (Part 2) for the list of matches for which you may nominate. **Before completing and returning the form to me, please read the notes below:**

- a) You should only nominate for the matches that you will be available for if selected.
- b) Please make a copy of the dates for which you have nominated.
- c) Should your availability change after returning this form you should notify the County Honorary Women's Secretary immediately. Donot wait to see if you are selected to play andthen withdraw.
- d) You may nominate for as many Friendly matches as you like but it is advisable that you nominate for at least 5 friendly games of which at least two should be away games.
- e) If you withdraw from any match for which you have been selected you must notify the Match Officer by telephone/e-mail as soon as possible giving an explanation.
- f) Complete your nomination by entering an 'X' in the boxes provided against each match and return to your Club Secretary who should forward all forms to the County Women's Secretary (by post or e-mail) before **14th March**. **Ensure you keep a record of your availability.**
- g) If selected as a Travelling Reserve you will be expected to attend the match. You will be selected for your next available match.
- h) Your day time contact telephone number is for emergency use only and will only be circulated to HB Match Officials on request. It is essential that a contact number is provided.
- i) Please note ALL games start at 1.30pm.you should aim to arrive by 1pm.
- j) For further information regarding County Dress Code and other match details please refer to the County Handbook (Match Rules) and the website – www.hertsba.com
- k) The matches against the County District Associations are now considered to be President's matches. The nominations for these will therefore be made through the Executive Secretary and selection by the Women's President – Betty Ottaway. Nominations for the President's mixed matches will be circulated separately.
- l) Transport to matches will need to be organised by players themselves. It is suggested, by the Executive Committee, that costs should be shared between the driver and passengers at a rate of 40p per mile.

Members wishing to nominate for the Johns/Walker squad should also complete the separate form as provided by Alan Spicer, the Team Manager
