MEN'S UNDER 25 TEAM MANAGER

Hertfordshire Bowls currently has a vacancy for a Men's U25 Team Manager and all interested parties should apply in writing to Mrs M. Dunstone, Honorary Executive Secretary no later than 28 February 2020. Your application should include explanation as to why you would like this role, including what you can bring to the role and your view on each of the role responsibilities shown below.

The responsibilities of this position are:

- 1. To manage the Team selected to play in the Bowls England White Rose Two Fours (U25) competition along with managing the U25 teams selected to play in any other competitions or leagues at such time as they may arise.
- 2. To encourage, by your support and attendance, bowlers up to 25 years of age in the County to attend the County Coaching Days organised and run by the Hertfordshire Bowls Coaching Society (HBCS) during the outdoor season.
- 3. The U25 Manager and Amy Rose Manager to mutually support one another so both genders progress together in a common structure with the objective of reaching the highest possible standards.
- 4. The Managers (both genders) to make their best endeavor to have at least one manager at Youth Coaching Days {Boot Camps}.
- 5. To work with the H.B. County Team Managers and the HBCS and their Coaches to ensure they adapt their sessions for young bowlers of both genders. This may be achieved with the help of the HB Squad Development & Academy's support, training workshops and session participation if requested.
- 6. To provide opinion, when requested, to The Middleton Cup and Johns Trophy Team Managers on U25 players' performance.
- 7. To attend and support the U25 County and National Competitions.
- 8. The Team Managers (both genders) will seek input from the HBCS Coaches when selecting teams to play in Youth Team matches and to attend and support those teams and matches, be they inter-county friendlies or matches held within the county.
- 9. To hold, or be working toward, a professional qualification in coaching (minimum Level 1). Familiarity with the BDA Coaches Code of Conduct is essential
- 10. To have a current Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) certificate.
- 11. Team Manager and Selectors shall not be eligible for selection.

Applications for the post of Men's U25 Manager will be reviewed by a panel from the County Selection Committee and suitable applicants will be invited to a formal interview.
