



MEN'S & WOMEN'S POINTS

Players wishing to play in County matches have to achieve SIXTEEN Points.

There is no time restriction on gaining these points.

When the required number of points is reached, players can apply to play for the County in the Inter County Friendly Matches. Points are not required to apply to play in the Inter-County Competitive Matches.

Points are awarded for the following:

National Competitions

One point awarded for winning each round in the following National Competitions:

Two Bowl Singles, Four Bowl Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours, Senior Fours, Junior Singles and Champion of Champions Four Bowl Singles.

One point for each round won in above competitions at the National Championships and British Isles Championships, where applicable.

Other Competitions:

UnBadged Singles: One point awarded for winning each round plus the winner to receive an additional 3 points.

Benevolent Triples (Women): Winners to be awarded 3 points, Runners Up 2 points and losing Semi Finalists 1 point.

Inter County Competitive Matches

One point awarded for playing in the following matches:

Men: Middleton Cup, Balcomb Trophy, Senior Eastern Counties League and Inter-Divisional League

Women: Johns Trophy and Walker Cup

A County Badge will be awarded once a player has achieved their 16 points and played in one Inter-County Friendly or Competitive Match (Junior Matches & Tour Matches excluded)

Points are only awarded to Non-County players. POINTS ARE NOW AUTOMATICALLY RECORDED BY THE COUNTY AND PLAYERS REACHING THEIR 16 POINTS WILL BE INFORMED.

Players reaching 16 points shall not be eligible to enter the UnBadged Singles Competition.

Players must ensure that they advise the relevant Competition Co-ordinator their team players names in Pairs, Triple & Fours competitions after each round won. Failure to do so may result in points not being recorded correctly. It is advisable to keep cards from each round just in case of query.
